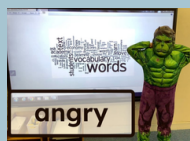
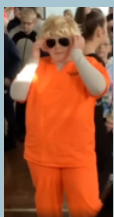
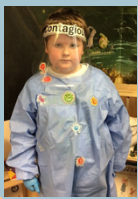
School Sleep Over

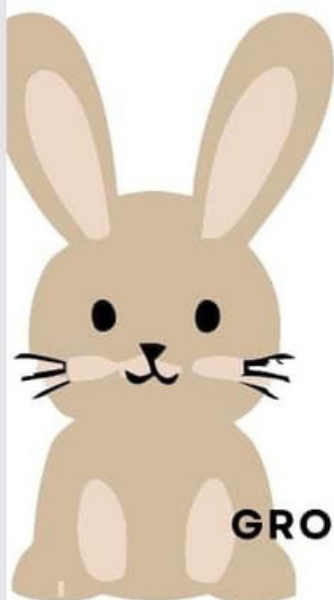
